SKATE PARK

Shildon Town Council was awarded £50,000 through the Inspired Facilities Fund (Sports England) for the refurbishment of their existing skate area in Hackworth Park.

The remaining funds were secured from Shildon Town Council and Durham County Council Neighbourhood Budget. This will enable the replacement of all the old steel ramps, with a new bespoke concrete park to include a variety of obstacles, rails and jumps.

Shildon's young people were invited to attend a consultation event to identify what they would like to see included in the new park. This informed the brief and five companies were invited to submit designs for the project. Again we invited the Young People of Shildon to come and view the designs and vote for their preferred solution, this identified the winning design.

Work on the skate park will start early September 2015.
