

BEAR NECESSITIES IN HACKWORTH PARK



If you go down to the park today your sure of a big surprise!

A newly installed Bear Chair, Toadstools and Fairy house were opened by the Town Mayor, Councillor Shirley Quinn in June (pictured above).

This was made possible by the support of Reverend David Tomlinson, St John's Church, staff and volunteers from Shildon Alive! A St John's Church Project, Shildon Town Council and, most importantly, the children from Timothy Hackworth Primary School.

Around thirty children were involved with planting up the new containers with an assortment of wildlife friendly plants to help attract bees and butterflies.

It is hoped that children, mums, dads and visitors to the park will stop and sit a while, taking a little time to listen and look at the wildlife around them. The new seating area will provide a great vantage point to see and hear the wildlife.

This new area was made possible by Shildon Alive! who successfully submitted a funding application to the Greggs Foundation, making it possible to develop this project to its conclusion. Well done to everyone who helped create this wonderful wildlife transformation for everyone to enjoy.
