

We were again treated to an inspiring range of artwork including, multimedia, textiles and creative drawing and painting, sculpture and accomplished photography.

The Town Mayor, Councillor Peter Quinn was on hand to thank all who produced artwork for the exhibition and spoke to children involved from the Shildon Primary Schools who were given access to the exhibition before it opened for public viewing.



The Town Council was successful in an application for Section 106 Funding from Durham County Council for the refurbishment of the under 5's and under 12's play area together with play equipment to be added to the teen area and the provision of a' hub' facility within Hackworth Park, Shildon.

Following extensive consultation with children and families, the under 5's/12's play area was re-opened on 18th July by the Town Mayor, Councillor Peter Quinn and Shirley Quinn and was attend by local children and Councillors. Throughout the day many local nurseries and groups visited the area and enjoyed the facilities. The Tennis Court area is now open for residents to enjoy, so why not give it a try!


