#### Extra cardboard

Recycle flattened cardboard in your recycling bin or at household waste recycling centres. Place extra cardboard by your bin and we will take it away as long as it is dry. If the cardboard is wet, we cannot recycle it.

#### **Extra recycling over Christmas**

If you have extra recycling, place it in a clear plastic bag (not a carrier bag or bin bag) next to your recycling bin and we will take it away.

#### **Christmas card recycling**

- Use your kerbside blue-lidded recycling bin only plain cards without stickers, glitter and decorations.
  - Make use of supermarket Christmas card recycling facilities.
    - Cut them up to make next year's festive gift tags.
